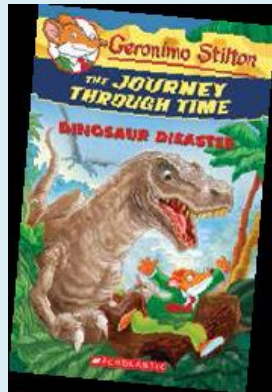
## Good News, Bad News by Jeff Mack

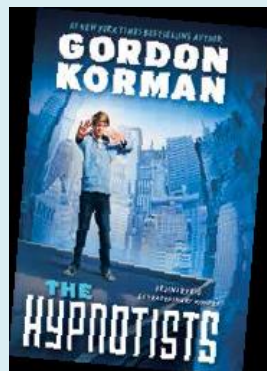
## Geronimo Stilton: The Journey Through Time: Dinosaur Disaster by Geronimo Stilton
