M. A. Milam schools will soon be implementing i-Ready Summer Lessons in Reading. These lessons have been carefully selected to support and enrich your children as they transition into the next grade level. The lessons will be available by June 8, 2018. The lessons should be completed by July 19, 2018. These lessons are highly recommended as they are necessary to your child's success in the 2018-2019 school year.

The lessons will be preprogrammed and can be accessed by logging in through the MDCPS Student Portal. The administration at Milam K-8 Center will be monitoring student progress throughout the summer. Each student can use the attached Home Summer Log 2018 to help keep track of the lessons completed. It is important that as parents you support your child by helping them organize their time. Students will need to work on i-Ready for approximately 30 minutes a day; 4 to 5 times a week. The student Home Summer Log 2018 has an area for parents to initial as the students complete each assignment.

When students return to school on August 20, 2018 the homeroom teachers will collect the completed Home Summer Log 2018 and give the student an extra-credit A for his/her summer work. Additionally, each student will receive a "Surprise Reward" from the Milam Administration.

The Milam family has always believed that a team effort is the best approach to the success of our students. We are looking forward to working together with our students' families to ensure they start the 2018-2019 school year in a positive manner.
